VOLUNTEER PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Must attend pre-volunteer meeting(s) or phone conference
- Volunteers will be assigned to teams within the organization. It's possible you may be on multiple teams if needed.
- There may be special projects and other special requests assigned on an as needed basis.
- Report to assignment at least 15 minutes prior to start of event/program and report to your assigned volunteer coordinator.
- Act as a representative of The Unique Friends Foundation while volunteering.

- Help promote & share event(s)

VOLUNTEERING FOR TUFF:

- Report to assignment at least 15 minutes before the start volunteering duty
- Conduct yourself as a professional and as a representative of TUFF
- No cell phones should be in use in public view while volunteering. If phone use is necessary, please let your coordinator/helper know and step away to make your call.
- Unless invited and supervised, children shouldn't be with you while you're volunteering.
- Volunteers agree to follow the social media guidelines stated during the pre-event volunteer meeting.

VOLUNTEER DRESS CODE:

- Dress modestly - making sure to avoid wearing anything that will be offensive or distracting to those with whom you are supporting and/or serving.
- The nature of where you're volunteering and the activities you will engage in should be an indicator of appropriate attire. Please take this information into consideration when determining your clothing.
- There will be events where all volunteers are required to wear TUFF t-shirts. These shirts will be provided at no cost.
- The following are unacceptable attire for any volunteer role:
 - Halter tops
 - Strapless dresses/tops
 - Spaghetti Straps
 - Visible undergarments
 - Mini dresses/mini skirts
 - Short shorts (above mid thigh)
 - Athletic Shorts (unless appropriate for the activity - will be discussed prior to event to clarify)
 - Low "V" or Scoop Neck shirts
 - T-Shirts w/ graphics, logos or slogans
